How to make the most of your vacation time?

1. Talk with leaders

- Discuss your vacation with leaders and elders.
- Ask for support for you and other church leaders in taking vacation time.
- Allow them to hold you accountable in respecting your vacation and disconnecting from work.

2. Plan for coverage

- Work with your district and circuit to plan for coverage during your time off.
- Make plans well ahead of your vacation.
- Plan coverage for worship and pastoral care.

3. Schedule vacation and stick to it

- Do not allow changes in plans to cancel your time off altogether.
- Ensure you take your vacation no matter what.

4. Take blocks of time away

• To get truly restful time away, you need more than a long weekend.

5. When you are on vacation, be on vacation!

- Don't do any work on your vacation. Others can continue the Lord's work until you return.
- Use the time to truly get away.
