How to use a welcome packet to support and encourage your neighbors?

1. Do a mailing twice a year

• Start by mailing information and resources to your neighbors.

2. Choose the two times of year

 During Advent and Lent are good times because you can invite neighbors to attend your Christmas and Easter services.

3. Think of the recipient in your messaging

- Where might the recipient be in life?

4. Raise up a group of volunteers

- Build a group who works on the neighbor connection packets exclusively.
- It takes time to do it well.

5. Be consistent

• It may take several mailings for neighbors to notice your consistency and therefore that you care for them.
