What to understand about stewardship of finances?

1. Stored service

- It represents a portion of what the Lord has given to you.
- Your money is owned by God, but you are entrusted with managing it.

2. One-of-a-kind congregation

- God has placed all of the members of your congregation together at this time at your church for a purpose.
- He has given you all the resources to accomplish your unique mission.
- Stewardship is important to ensure that the financial resources are used in the best way to execute your ministries.

3. Ministry emphasis

- It is important to connect any project to ministry opportunities.
- Younger givers are less inclined to give to the church simply because it is the church. They want to
 know the money is being put toward a key service or ministry to serve the community.
