Your Ministries #2 - Bibles

Every member of your congregation should have a Bible, know how to use it, and spend regular time in God's Word.

How to encourage regular use of the Bible?

1. Regularly lift up the Bible

- Make sure your members recognize how much of the worship service come directly from scripture.
- Hold up the physical Bible during services.

2. Be sure everyone has a Bible

- Make sure everyone has a physical Bible that is practical for regular use.
- cph.org has many great options that you can share with members.
- Many churches give every member a Bible.

3. Teach how to use the Bible

- Most people aren't taught how to use the Bible outside of confirmation classes.
- Carve out time during worship to teach the Bible and how to use it.

4. Encourage people to bring Bibles to worship

- Ask people to use their Bibles during the service, turning to the passages as they are discussed.
- Model Bible use during worship.
- Remind members how our faith and worship practice is bound to the scripture.

5. Regularly encourage people to take time in the Word at home

- Options include congregation-wide reading plans and sending weekly Bible reading reminders.
- Make reading the Bible part of the rhythm of your congregation's life.
