## Engaging Segments of the Congregation: Empty Nesters Rev. Tom Eggebrecht LCEF Senior Vice President Ministry Solutions

Once children move out of the house, parents suddenly have a lot more time on their hands to devote to other pursuits, including volunteering at church. Empty nesters are a group that can be a great asset to your congregation and should be intentionally engaged.

### How to engage empty nesters in ministry?

#### Use a Rite of Godspeed

- Use a Rite of Godspeed (found in the Lutheran Service Book: Agenda) to send students off after graduation.
- It is a good start to the next phase of life to have Christ in their hearts and your prayers sending them
  on.

#### 2. Invite parents to a Rite of Commissioning

- Commission parents as servants of the church on the Sunday following the Rite of Godspeed for their kids.
- An installation of servants of the congregation can also be found in the Lutheran Service Book: Agenda.

#### 3. Commission empty nesters

- Spend the springtime recruiting and preparing the parents of recent graduates for their time as empty nesters, positioning them for specific volunteer opportunities.
- Help them transition from the parents of high schoolers to newly refreshed and engaged empty nesters.
