Planning for the Fall #5 – Volunteer Consecration and Celebration Week

Congregations are run, in large part, by volunteers called by God to serve the church in various ways.

How to celebrate volunteers and get more people engaged?

1. Choose a Sunday and week

- Select a time when folks are back from summer but are not too far into fall activities.
- Consider activities beyond Sunday like appreciation dinners and personal visits.

2. Build out a volunteer guide

- Name the opportunity.
- Provide a brief job description.
- Share the time commitment, including length of service.
- Include a section for sign-up contact info.
- Update the guide twice a year.
- Include an exhaustive list of volunteer opportunities.

3. Plan a consecration and celebration event

- Write a service that speaks to your people and blesses them and their work.
- Can take place on Sunday during or after worship or be a special event during the week.

4. Publish opportunities

• Make all volunteer opportunities known throughout the year.

5. Don't forget children and youth

- Target the young people who are currently volunteering.
- Have children shadow an adult volunteer.
- Include a youth representative on the church council.
- Schedule youth to read lessons in the service.
